Bottled under crown cap at 2 brix to finish fermentation

Unfined, unfiltered, not disgorged or cold-stabilized

• The Name: Each of our wines from Kick On Ranch bears a Latin name. Cobolorum means "goblin," which is our affectionate nickname for the Riesling vines. We call it #NaughtyGoblinBubbles; it is extremely fizzy and needs to be chilled completely before serving. We recommend popping the crown cap over the sink with a glass in hand. Natural sediment will rise from the bottom after uncapping, to create the "cloud of delicious."
