- Racked once before bottling
- 15ppm SO2 added before bottling (only addition of any kind)
- Unfined & unfiltered
- Bottled August 10, 2020
- <u>The Name</u>: Each of our wines from Kick On Ranch bears a Latin name. "Audire" (pronounced *Aw-DEE-ray*) means "listen." We strive to listen to the vineyard, the growing season, the fruit; we believe this wine has something to say.
